## CONTAINER WEIGHT DECLARATION IN DGOFFICE

As of 1 July 2016, shippers are required to verify container weights before loaded aboard ships. In 2014, the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) amendment was approved by IMO's Maritime Safety Committee with the purpose of reducing safety risks. We implemented a document in DGOffice.net to specify the Verified Gross Mass for a shipping container (as specified in SOLAS Chapter VI).
